- Check for a microchip microchiphelp.com. Local veterinary clinics, El Campo Animal Shelter and 3. SPOT all have microchip readers.
- Make and print a flyer about the lost/found pet at petbond.com/, and post a brightly colored poster in your 4. yard.
- 5. Post on Nextdoor.com and PawBoost.
- 6. Contact FedEx, UPS drivers in your area, and your postal carrier. They may have seen the pet or know who the owner is while they're on their rounds.
