

Lost & Found Pet Checklist



1. Contact your local shelter (El Campo-see below, Wharton-Wharton Police Dept. (979.532.3131), Wharton County Sheriff's Office (979.532.1550) and/or KULP Trading Post (979.543.9191) to report a lost/found pet.
2. Take a digital photo of the pet and post on Facebook – your profile and pages listed below, with location lost/found and a phone number:

3. Check for a microchip – microchiphelp.com. Local veterinary clinics, El Campo Animal Shelter and SPOT all have microchip readers.
4. Make and print a flyer about the lost/found pet at petbond.com/, and post a brightly colored poster in your yard.
5. Post on Nextdoor.com and PawBoost.
6. Contact FedEx, UPS drivers in your area, and your postal carrier. They may have seen the pet or know who the owner is while they're on their rounds.
7. Place flyers in the area where the pet was lost/found and at local veterinary clinics:
